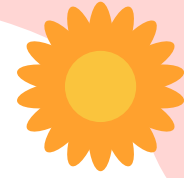

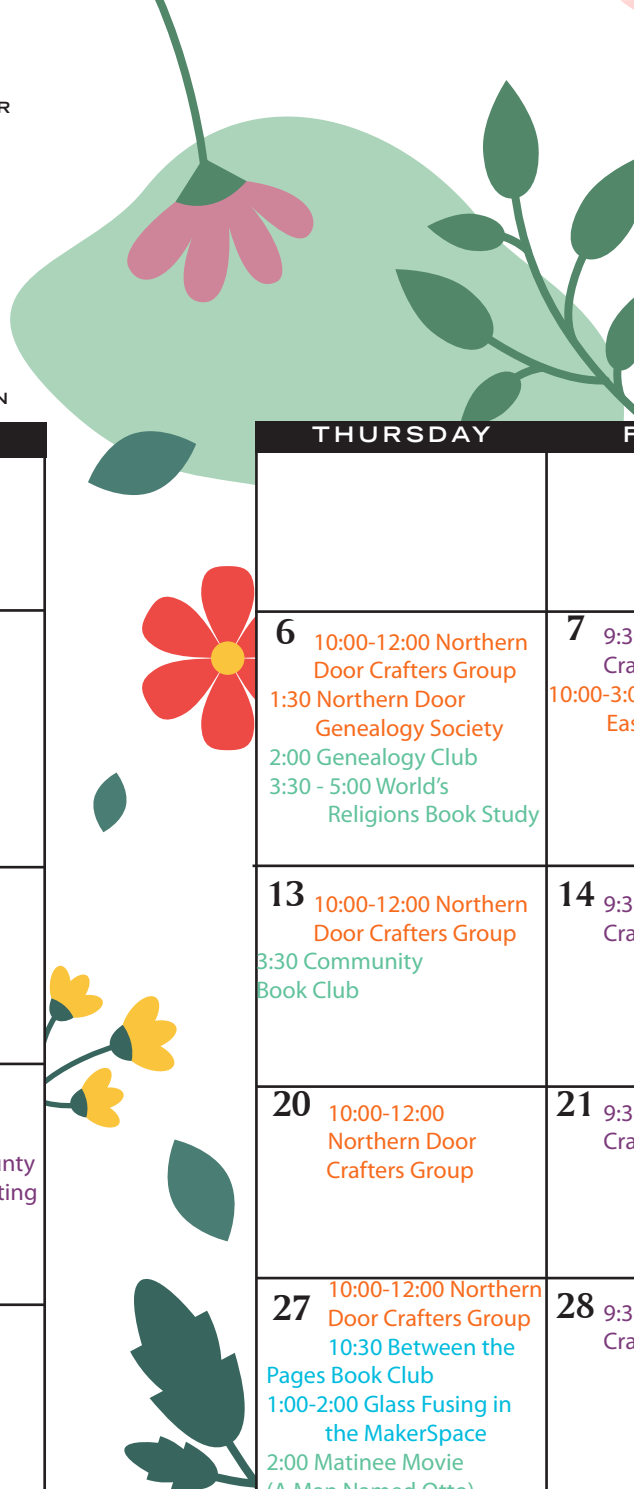

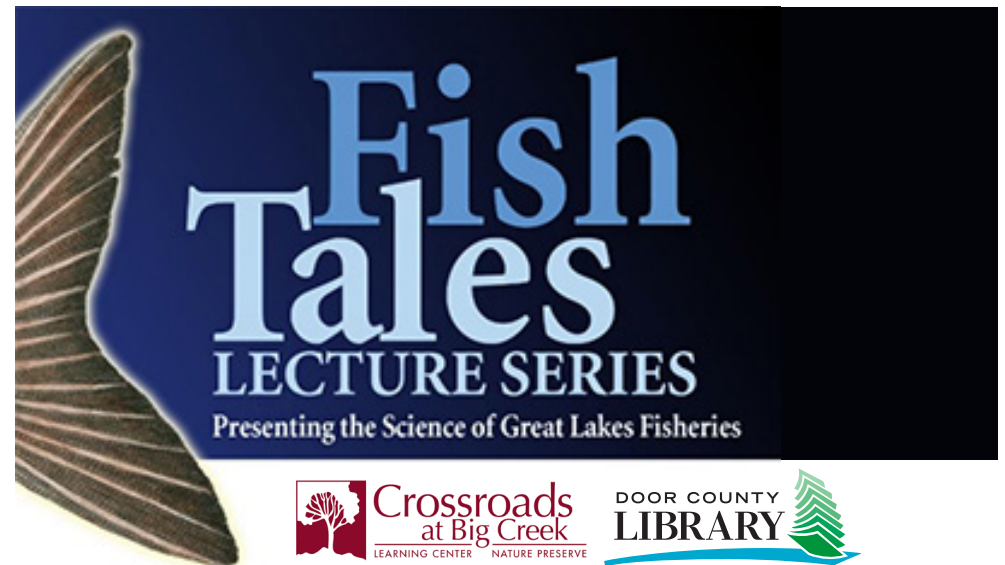

Development of Selective Connectivity for Fish Passage and Invasive Species Control at FishPass presented by Dr. Daniel Zielinski. Learn how science and engineering are being applied to achieve bi-directional, selective fish passage and controls sea lamprey on the Boardman River near Traverse City. There is great interest to reconnect key tributaries to the lake proper across the Great Lakes. Learn how the experimental approach at the Boardman River will inform improved fish passage that prevents range expansion of key invasive species. Fish Tales 2023 is an educational outreach of Crossroads of Big Creek offered in partnership with the Door County Library.
